INT. HOSPITAL - GWEN GRABER'S ROOM - DAY 12

> GWEN GRABER (early 40's) is hooked up to a Video EEG that monitors her brain waves, a mad scientist with a lot of wires shooting out of her head. She has a stack of paperwork on her lap. Derek, Izzie and George enter. Sc. 1

DEREK Good morning, Ms. Graber.

GWEN Really? "Good morning?" You haven't let me sleep in three nights. This ridiculous hat is destroying my selfesteem and I still haven't had a seizure. But, okay, we'll go with "Good moxning" if it makes you feel

better about yourself.

DEREK Ms. Graber is here for brain-mapping. Dr. Stevens?

IZZIE Brown mapping. Um -- you're trying to locate the area of the brain where the seizures originate so you can surgically remove it with minimal damage-to-the surrounding tissue;

Excellent.

DEREK

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GWEN

Excellent except for the fact that it's not working, and I'm losing billable hours. Unless anybody here is looking to get out of a bad marriage?

IZZIE/GEORGE

Nope./Single.

GWEN

Dr. Snepherd?

DEREK

I'm good, thanks.

GWEN

Really? Because I am an excellent divorce attorney. And there was a look. Between these two.

DEREK

A look?

IZZIE/CEORGE

No - sir -/ No look.

GWEN

What is it? Married young and now you have nothing in common? Oh no wait -- I got it -- the conversation is still good but the sex has gone to pot. Am I right?

Derek is thrown. A beat, then:

Doctors. A word?

Izzie and George follow Derek into the hallway.

GWEN

(to herself) I'm so right.

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GWEN

INT. GWEN GRABER'S ROOM - NIGHT 38

Derek sits with Gwen. Izzie and George stand nearby, knowing they're gonna get in some trouble. Sc. 2

DEREK

Well, Ms. Graber, the bad news is you had the mother of all seizures. A grand mal. The good news is we mapped it and now we can operate.

GWEN

No. I've decided against surgery, Dr. Shepherd.

DEREK

I'm sorry?

GWEN

No offense, I know you were eager to 'dig around in my brain -- but it's my brain -- and the risks of craniotomy -- when you described them they weren't terribly appealing.

Yes, there are risks. But you have to weigh those risks against the detrimental effect your seizure disorder has on your life.

GWEN

Unless it's my life that has a detrimental effect on my seizure disorder. -- It's like with you and your wife: is the bad sex the biggest problem or are all the bigger problems causing the bad sex?

DEREK

I...am just not going to answer that.

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GWEN

My point is, I was in here for four days. And it was the best vacation I ever had. And I had more fun today than I can remember. ... I don't have any friends. I don't have any fun. I only have work. Work and seizures. And it's not a coincidence that when the work stopped, the seizures stopped -- until these two started arguing.

DEREK

Which I plan to talk to them about.

GWEN

No -- you don't get it. They did it on purpose.

DEREK

(not buying it)

Did they.

Izzie and George smile and nod -- seizing on the lie to get them out of trouble.

GWEN

The caffeine didn't work -- the games, the TV -- I was having fun. But watching people fight, that's been my whole life for 15 years. So -I'm changing my life. And if that doesn't work, I'll come back here and let you cut open my brain.

Off Gwen, genuinely happy...
